

Group Clay Pigeon Shooting Packages



Adventure Sports operates a professional clay pigeon shooting ground at Wedgnoek Rifle Range in Warwick. Wedgnoek provides an ideal venue for entertaining corporate clients, employees and guests.

Wedgnoek is a full time shooting ground run by CPSA (Clay Pigeon Shooting Association) senior instructors who deliver first class instruction, targets and equipment to all of our guests. Detailed below are three group clay pigeon shooting packages that are suitable for non-shooters or shooters with limited experience.

Clay Shooting Experience Session

This is a short session ideally suited to groups who would like to have a go a clay shooting. Each guest will shoot approximately 20 shots under the supervision of a CPSA instructor.

The clay shooting experience will last one hour and costs £30 per person, including VAT, based on a minimum billing of six guests.

Fifty Shot Group Clay Shooting Challenge

This half-day package is an ideal way to entertain groups of up to 40 guests. The following itinerary describes how a typical event would operate for a group of twelve guests.

- 9.45 AM Guests arrive at Wedgnoek Shooting Ground in Warwick, tea / coffee is served.
- 10.00 AM The event manager will introduce the guests to the instructors and explain how the morning will operate. Safety points will be covered and all guests will be issued with ear protection and safety glasses.
- 10.10 AM Guests are divided into teams of approximately six people and taken out to their first shooting area. The instructor will carefully explain the principles behind shooting the target before the guests take their turn. All the targets are scored to allow a "high gun" to be found at the end of the event.
- 10.40 AM Teams finish on their first shooting stand and circulate around to their second area.
- 11.10 AM After the second stand the teams will return to the Clubhouse for refreshments.
- 11.20 AM Third stand.
- 11.50 AM Fourth and final stand.
- 12.20 PM Teams return to the Clubhouse to hear the scores for the morning and for the presentation of a bottle of champagne to the winning team.
- 12.30 PM Guests depart or stay on for lunch.

50 Shot Session Costs

The following costs and durations apply to the 50 shot clay shooting sessions.

Numbers of Guests	Cost per person (Including VAT)	Duration
1 – 3	£65	1 – 1 ½ hours
4 – 7	£60	1 ½ - 2 ½ hours
8 and over	£55	2 – 2 ½ hours

100 Shot Corporate Shoot and Team Flush

This third option will have a similar format to the fifty shot session, but will include additional stands and a two-man flush at the end of the event.

The flush involves two shooters working together to hit as many targets as possible. The targets are thrown from a variety of traps, in a random order. The targets keep coming and the pair of shooters need to work together to use their combined 40 shots effectively.

This option can be spread over a longer time period, typically 10.00 AM 3.00 PM to allow for the additional shooting and a break for lunch.

Catering for this option will include: Tea / coffee throughout, bacon rolls & orange juice upon arrival, cottage pie lunch followed by treacle sponge pudding and a bottle of Moët for the winning team and the highest scoring pair on the flush.

This option will cost £115 per person including VAT, based on a minimum of ten guests.
