

# Example Half Day Mixed Activity Event



A mixed activity event is an excellent way to entertain a group of people. This example illustrates how a group of 24 guests can be entertained for a half day.

A similar format can be used for smaller and larger groups. It is simply a case of adjusting the number of teams and duration to ensure every guest has a really good go at each of the activities.

## Suggested Programme of Events

This suggested itinerary is based around a morning event. The same format can easily be applied to an afternoon or even an evening (depending on daylight).

- 9.30 AM Guests arrive at Wedgnock Rifle Range, Warwick. Tea / coffee is served and an initial briefing will be given to explain the format for the morning and to address general safety points. The guests will then be divided into teams of between five and seven people.
- 10.00 AM Instructors take each team out to their first activity. A full briefing will be given and guests will all try the activity. Scores will be kept throughout to provide a competitive feel to the day.
- 10.45 AM First activity ends. Teams circulate around to their second activity.
- 11.30 AM Third activity.
- 12.15 PM Fourth activity.
- 1.00 PM All activities end. Guests return to Clubhouse where scores are announced and prizes presented.
- 1.20 PM Guests depart or stay on for lunch.



Each team will take part in all four activities during the morning. Scores are kept throughout to allow a winning team to be found at the end of the event.

## **Activities**

Any four of the following activities can be fitted into this itinerary:



### ***4x4 Off Road Driving***

Each guest will be given expert tuition on how to drive and control a fully equipped Landrover. A challenging course is used that incorporates inclines, descents, water splashes and lots of mud.

### ***Powerturn Driving***

This bizarre two-seater vehicle is powered by two 195 cc engines. Each driver controls one engine to produce a very amusing and fun driving activity. Teamwork and laughter are essential!



### ***Quad Bikes***

Drive these 250 cc four wheeled motorbikes around a challenging obstacle course incorporating tight corners, mud and rough ground. The competitors are scored depending on their driving ability and skill.

### ***Reverse Steer Snooker***

This converted Jeep provides one of the funniest activities you'll ever experience. The objective is to drive the car through a series of snooker ball coloured gates accumulating the highest break possible along the way. The problem is when the car is steered left it will go right and throw a couple of blindfolds in – the result is hilarious!



### ***Air Pistol & Rifle Shooting***

Ten shot Smith & Wesson revolvers are used to test the marksmanship of the team. These state of the art pistols are powered by Carbon Dioxide gas and allow pinpoint accuracy using single shots against paper targets or rapid fire in a speed based competition. Full powered air rifles are also used for longer range targets.

### **Archery**

An experienced archery instructor will take the guests through a series of practice sessions and scored competition rounds using Recurve Longbows. A traditional skill based event that allows any guest to become proficient.



### **Clay Pigeon Shooting**

A CPSA qualified instructor will take the team through the basics of shooting clay pigeons. Each individual will use a 12-gauge shotgun to shoot at a variety of targets.

### **Argocats**

These six wheeled vehicles are amphibious and can literally go anywhere. They steer in the same way as a tank, and participants will enjoy manoeuvring the vehicle around a course of mud, water, hills and turns.



### **Grass Karts**

Guests will take it in turn to drive these powerful racing machines around a large dirt track. Once each team member has had a few practice laps they will take it in turns to race against the clock.

### **Empire Crate Building Team Exercise**

The team is equipped with 50 milk crates with which they must form the tallest tower possible. The tower must hold the weight of one team member at its summit (they are connected to a safety line for when the tower eventually falls over)!



### **Missile Mission**

Teams are given all the equipment to build and decorate their own rocket. They also have a supply of rocket engines which will enable the rocket to be fired several hundred feet up into the air. The challenge is to select the right combination to enable the rocket to land as close to a target as possible. Huge fun for the whole team.

### ***Segway Riding***

These hi-tec, battery powered machines are capable of over 12 miles an hour in an off-road environment. Movement is controlled by body position and some clever electronics. Participants start at low speed to gain confidence, before they tackle a winding cross-country course.



### ***Poles Apart Team Building Exercise***

Each team member must sign his or her name on a pad of paper. Unfortunately the paper is in the centre of a minefield. A structure must therefore be made from wooden poles and ropes to allow each person to reach the paper.

### ***UXB Team Building Exercise***

A large unexploded bomb must be defused before the timer reaches zero. The bomb must be recovered from its resting-place and defused. Nerves of steel are required for this task.



### ***Terex 360° Digger Challenge***

The 360° digger is the king of the construction site. These huge machines can scoop up tonnes of soil at a time and swivel on the spot. The challenge is to scoop footballs from the top of cones and drop them into a basket.

## Costs

The event can easily be run for a different duration by altering the number of activities. The table below sets out typical durations and costs for different numbers of activities:

## Special Activities

There are several activities that are more expensive to operate and command a slightly higher cost. Any of the following could be selected for inclusion in the event – the additional cost is shown in brackets after the description.

### ***Quad Bike Trekking***

Drive a powerful all-terrain quad bike through 100 acres of challenging countryside incorporating slopes, mud, grassland and picturesque woodland. The trek starts with a training session to ensure the participants know how to ride and control bike and progresses through to challenging routes through dense woodland, mud, water and harsh terrain. *(Additional £640)*



### ***Armoured Personnel Carrier Driving***

These 15 tonne armoured vehicles are highly manoeuvrable and provide the feeling of real power. The dips, turns and slopes allow the potential of these vehicles to be exposed. There is space for up to six people to ride in the back allowing the whole team to experience the driving skill (or lack of it) of the driver. *(Additional £2,000)*

Drive a full size tractor around an undulating, muddy area. These vehicles are designed for the harshest conditions and can prove to be a real challenge to drive. *(Additional £410)*



### **The Yorkie Bar Experience**

Drive this monster 40 foot articulated lorry around out internal roads and have a go at reversing – it'll make you appreciate those boys delivering in towns! Everyone has always wanted to have a go at being a trucker – go on, admit it! *(Additional £440)*

### **Hovercraft**

Riding on a cushion of air, the hovercraft provides a truly unique experience, which offers an unusual test of co-ordination skills and balance. Team members are scored on how they negotiate a large flagged circuit. *(Additional £440)*
