

Example Hotel Treasure Hunt



This example hotel based treasure hunt will keep a group of 100 guests entertained for approximately two hours.

The aim of the treasure hunt is for each team to answer questions, collect objects, solve cryptic clues, interrogate characters and participate in photographs. Scores are awarded based upon the efforts of the team.

Each team will have a pack containing a map of the hotel and clues to lead the team to a wide range of locations both inside and outside. As the teams make their way around the hotel they will encounter a number of elements to allow them to earn points. The elements will include:



Questions

The teams will all be issued with a sheet of questions and pictures that will require investigation and inspection to find the answers. The team will need to search the hotel to discover the solutions.

Wandering Characters

Located around the hotel and grounds the guests will find a number of unusual characters. The teams will need to question them to discover an answer. Typical characters include:

Local Farmer – A traditional farmer, keen on sheep but not so accommodating towards strangers!

Kev the Burberry Boy – Kev is the proud owner of a lovely car, fully kitted out with a thumping sound system and furry dice. This Burberry clad street dude will provide answers to questions but only if you compliment his fantastic road machine.

Doctor – A very keen character who will pay a bit too much attention to the medical needs of your guests. Guests may come away with bandages, plasters and slings if they are to gain any clues.

Stalkers

Two stalkers will roam around the hotel wearing distinctive hats. If a stalker catches a team they will challenge them with a forfeit. The team can choose to decline the challenge and lose points from their final score or they can be sporting and try the challenge.

Example challenges could include:

- Morris dance for one minute.
- Recreate a scene from a famous movie.

Photo Booth

Scavenger

The teams will be given a list of items that should be collected. Items could include:

- Bird feather
- Map of Australia
- An out of date tax disk

Prizes

Following the treasure hunt the scores for the event will be announced and prizes presented to the following teams:

- Best overall team (bottle of champagne to each team member).
- Lowest scoring team (wooden spoon to each team member).
- Characters special award – decided by the three characters (a Burberry cap for each team member – to be worn throughout the evening).
- Stalkers Booby Prize – awarded to the least impressive team by the stalkers (a bag of humbug sweets).
